scripture for week 2

Matt 13:5 | Others fell on the rocky places, where they did not have much soil; and immediately they sprang up, because they had no depth of soil. But when the sun had risen, they were scorched; and because they had no root, they withered away.

Matt 13:20 | The one on whom seed was sown on the rocky places, this is the man who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; yet he has no firm root in himself, but is only temporary, and when affliction or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he falls away.

message for the week

The soil that is found between rocks is very shallow and when seeds fall in this soil, they germinate, but cannot root deeply enough because of the rocks and lack of moisture.

If we spend time seeking God and reading His Word every day, then what we learn is embedded in our minds and not easily forgotten. This is like the deep roots of a strong plant.

We need to be very disciplined with our time. There is always enough time in a day for us to set some aside in order to seek God's heart and will for our lives. We need to read the Word and ask God for understanding and wisdom on how to apply it to our lives. We need to ask Him for direction every day in order to become strong and well rooted.

activity for the week

This week we are going to paint and decorate our rocks that we collected last week.

Use paint or old nail polish or simply use crayons or felt pens (kookies). Decorate your rocks with reminders to seek God, and place them in the garden or in pot plants, or use them around the house. Whenever you see them, ask God to help you ensure that His Word becomes deeply rooted in your heart.

Preparation for next week: Collect various leaves and flowers for pressing. Arrange them between sheets of paper and place inside heavy books. Leave them there until we need them for an upcoming activity.
